- □ To increase the rate of success of our PhD studies

Another priority has appeared from the upper levels (University and Ministry) after the Strategic Plan was approved: To increase the graduation rate

Rate of success = number of successful defenses/number of students in the 4th and higher years of study

Graduation rate = number of successful
