

## **HYBRID LECTURES IN WS 23/24**

# **STUDY REGULATIONS**

□ Please make sure you READ the Student Manual!


- □ Limited number of times you can register for each subject during the whole time of study :
- Mandatory and Elective Mandatory twice at maximum
- Elective once at maximum
- Three attempts to pass the class exam retakes only allowed if you have failed the previous attempt(s).
- □ Minimum amount of credits required per year see <u>HERE</u>
- Maximum period of studies 6 year for bachelors; 5 year for masters

# **DEGREE RECOGNITION = NOSTRIFICATION**

- Only for the purpose of the study at FSV UK can be done by FSV
  - Submit notarized copy of Diploma and transcript at registration
  - If you don't have it available yet bring it to IOASAP
- For the official degree recognition for other purposes
  - Submit the application to the Rectorate CU

# **CZECH LANGUAGE COURSES**

#### Czech as a Foreign Language



Czech language courses are especially designed for students from degree programmes and Erasmus students (including students from other university faculties). They are taught from the beginner level and students can enroll in each course both in the winter and summer semester.

#### **Tuition fees:**

Degree programme students do not pay an extra fee. This will be settled with the institute they study at.

Erasmus and PhD. students pay **4,800,-** CZK per semester in the Hollar building at the cash office.



# **REGISTRATION INTO STUDIES**

Formal enrolment into studies in several steps:

- 1) Online enrolment into studies in Student information system (instructions sent via email)
- 2) Registration for in-person appointment through Student information system (instructions to be sent later on via email)
  - in-person appointments: **11 -30 September**
  - Later arrivals: Dates of in-person appointments to be set individually after 30th September
- 3) In-person registration at Hollar building:
  - What to bring with yourself:
    - ID card
    - Notarized copy of Diploma + Diploma supplement (Transcript) for more information on Nostrification, please see the following <u>link</u> and <u>link</u>
  - Study and financial contracts to be signed during the in-personregistration:

## **FINISHING YOUR STUDIES**

 Requirements:
 Obtain enough credits (180 for BA/120 for MA)
 Pass all mandatory courses/electives according to your program's plan Submit your thesis
 Pass Final State exams (several parts depending on the program)

- Final Thesis = extended piece of original academic writing supervised by Academic supervisor
- □ More information on the Thesis and Finale state exams <u>here</u>

- Non-EU: Student visas's/student residence permits expire by the date of the successful completion of the final state exam/thesis defence
  If you plan to stay in Czechia, apply for your job seeker visa as soon as
- the final state exam/thesis defense is successfuly over
