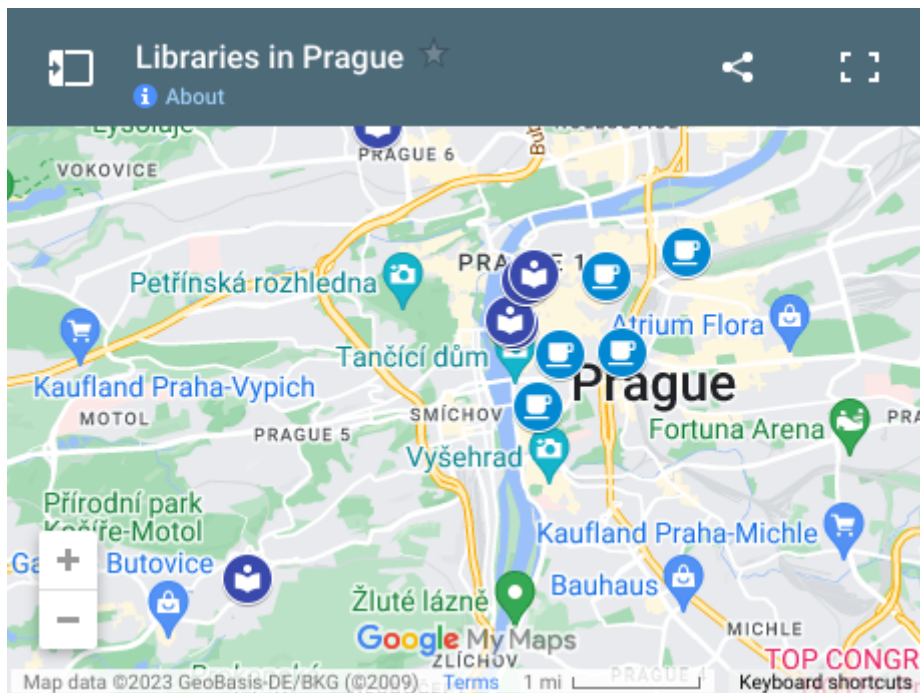

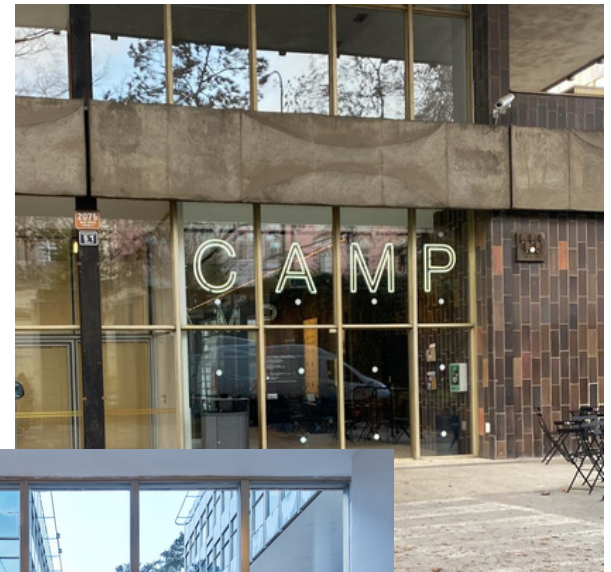
### CENTRE FOR ARCHITECTURE AND METROPOLITAN PLANNING
