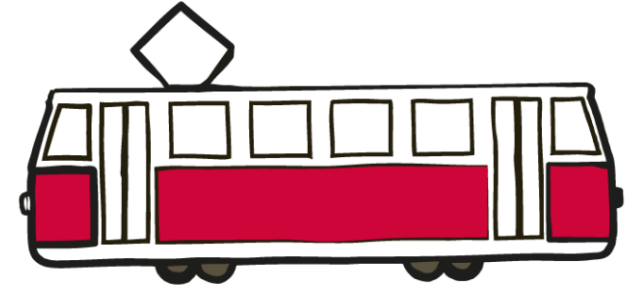

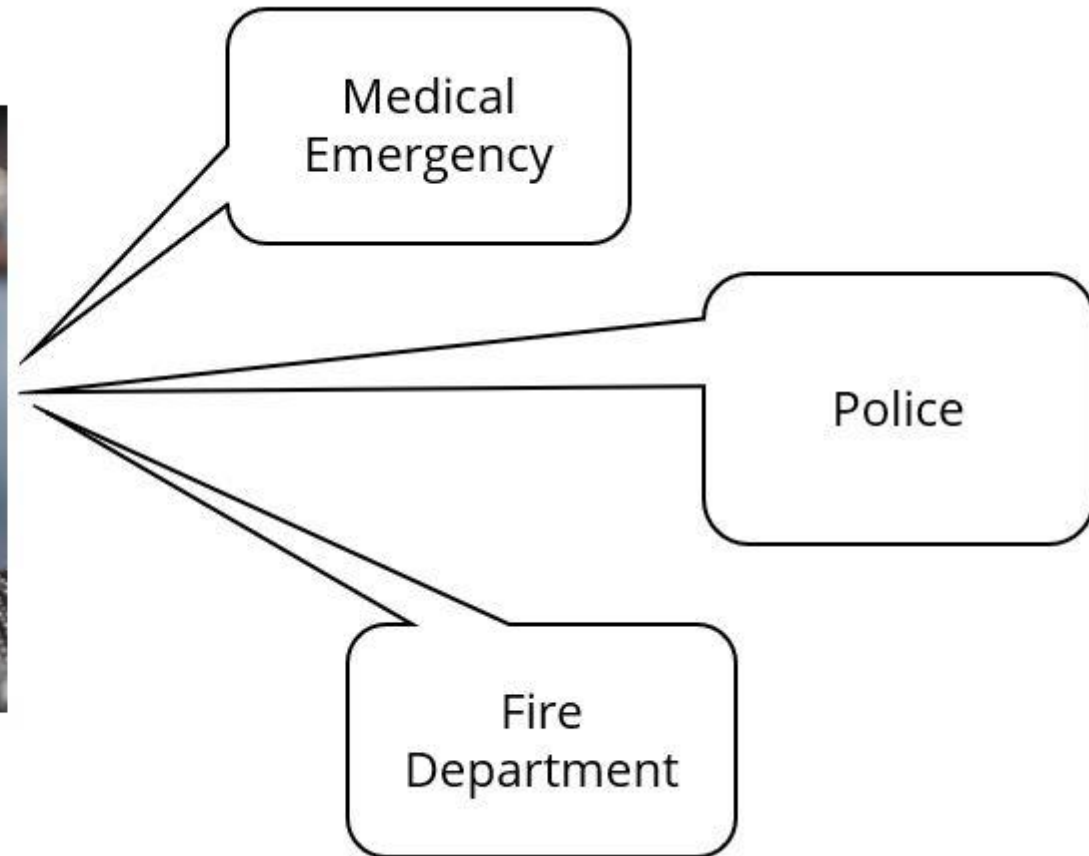

EMERGENCY CONTACTS - TIPS

If you feel sick and it is not life threatening, contact your insurance company first.

Have an emergency contact written and stored in your wallet. (contact of your parents or partner who could be contacted in CoE)

Make a copy of your ID or passport, carry only one document at a time.

Be ware of pickpocketing (in public transport, crowded streets, bars,...)!

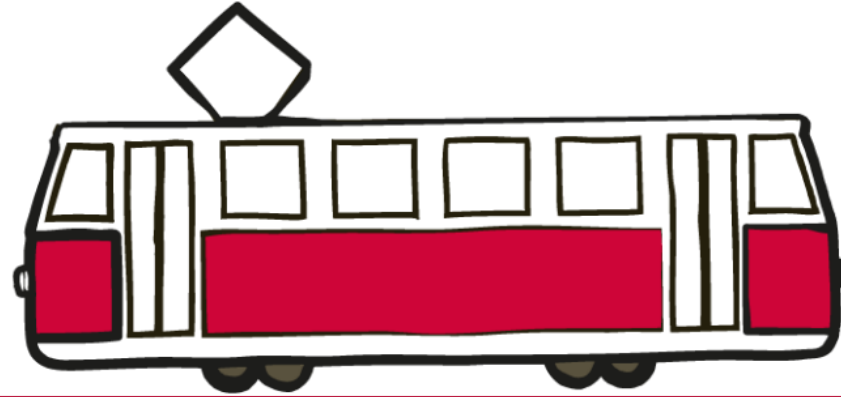
If you lose your wallet (ID, Credit Card, cash...) – contact the Police, block your Credit Card, contact the Embassy
