The 4EU+ Local Office at CU is seeking enthusiastic students eager to actively shape the future of Europe and participate in the campaign that the 4EU+ Alliance is planning for the upcoming European elections. The main goal of the initiative is to raise awareness of these elections among young voters and to highlight the importance of active citizenship in the European context. The campaign will also highlight the key role of universities and the importance of international cooperation, for example through European University Alliances, in the democratic process. The initiative will include activities such as a social media campaign, student competitions, and other online and in-person events.

<u>The 4EU+ Alliance</u> is a partnership of eight leading European universities working together to create a shared academic environment and focus on strengthening European education and research. The main goals of the Alliance include supporting academic excellence and strengthening European identity with an emphasis on democracy, freedom, and interdisciplinary cooperation.



Your involvement in the project is planned from December to June. Your main task will be to coordinate activities and an international team across the 4EU+ universities, develop a content concept of the campaign and ensure its implementation. We are looking for a communicative student interested in European politics and the future of Europe. Fluency in English is essential. Knowledge of marketing strategies and principles is an advantage.

What's in it for you? First of all, a unique opportunity to actively participate in a strategically significant international university project. But you won't be doing it for free. We estimate that you will work 20-30 hours per month on the project, so you will also be paid via a stipend or a DPP.

You will contribute to the content of the campaign, apply your knowledge of English, and gain valuable experience in implementing a project in an international team of young people. Although the involvement is primarily conceived as voluntary, we will try to provide support in the form of scholarships for active students.
