The admission process for our Bachelor's programs is online only and there is no entrance exam. We will evaluate your application solely on the basis of the documents

you will have submitted, such as a proof of your previous studies, a transcript of records, a CV and motivation letter, and a document showing your level of English proficiency. Some programs require additional documents, such as a proof of your level of mathematics.
