Health Insurance Information	
Health insurance regulations	<p>It is mandatory for exchange students to have suitable and adequate insurance for the entire period of their study at CityU. The insurance should cover but not limited to travel, personal accidents, medical expenses (accident and non-accident), hospitalisation and emergency evacuation/repatriation.</p> <p>If exchange students do not have their own insurance coverage before coming to Hong Kong, or if they wish to buy additional insurance, they may enrol in the CityU-contracted insurance plan. The CityU-contracted insurance plan is available to all non-local students, and it provides relatively basic coverage such as personal accident and medical benefits.</p> <p>Students will be invited to enrol in the CityU-contracted insurance plan when they fill-out the online pre-enrolment form. Once they have opted in the plan, they will not be allowed to opt out afterwards, and they will have to settle the insurance payment accordingly.</p> <p>The insurance premium for the academic year 2018-19 was HK\$254 per student (around USD33).
