What to do if you feel unwell (<u>typical symptoms</u>) or have been in contact with someone who is Covid-19 positive

Please note that there are currently no special Covid-19 requirements in place at the central university level. However, please pay attention to the requirements stated by the Czech Health Ministry.

- The minimal duration of the self-isolation is **7 days** from a positive PCR test result.
- During the self-isolation, you are required to avoid contact with other persons and to wear an **FFP2 respirator** in all shared and public interior places
- The isolation period can be terminated only in the case that you don't have any Covid-19 symptoms **during the 3 last days** of the minimal isolation period
- It is not possible to end your isolation earlier, not even with a negative test result
- A positive antigen test has to be **confirmed by a PCR test** please check the list of testing points (here).
- Referrals for a PCR test are issued by a general practitioner based on Covid-19 symptoms.

During the isolation period, you can use **delivery services** (online supermarkets) such as www.kosik.cz, www.rohlik.cz, www.itesco.cz, Pharmacy: www.pilulka.cz (Should you feel unwell the most typical medicine for fever and flu symptoms are called Paralen, Panadol.), which also provides pharmacy delivery.
