## Research Presentation Competition – Hollar Building, room H215

Introductory Session: after a short introduction, our senior researcher Professor Julie Chytilova presents her research on: "Communicating doctors' consensus persistently increases COVID-19 vaccinations". Her article (with three other coauthors) appeared in "Nature" – one of the best world's interdisciplinary journals – last June.
