Who can participate: PhD Students of FSV UK and fresh postdocs = academic or research employees of FSV UK that have defended their dissertation thesis later than January 1st, 2019.

Which research can be presented: Research that has been published in original articles in English in the year 2020, articles must be in <u>OBD</u> till January 10<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Authors with more articles can compete just with one of them.

Application: Please, look <u>here</u> for more understanding of the competition format. You can apply <u>here</u> till January 10<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Necessary condition is that you upload with your application a five minute video that introduces your research.

Rules:

Participants present a poster about their research during the poster session. Poster session will be on February 9th from 16:10 to 20:00 in <u>Zoom on this link</u>. Choice of finalists will be at 18:30 by voting of all PhD Students of FSV UK and fresh postdocs present in Zoom. Three best presentations will go into the final + the best presentation form participants from the institutes that are not among the three best presentations.

Finalists present during the final in random order. Final will be on February 10th from 16:10 to 20.00 in <u>Zoom on this link</u>. Each finalist gets 10 minutes for their presentation + 10 more minutes for discussion. Winner will be chosen by voting of a jury and by voting of all PhD Students of FSV UK and fresh postdocs present in Zoom at 19:00, both votings have the same weight. Jury will have five members, from each institute one.

Price for winner: Dean's price 10.000,-CZK
