## *Research Presentation Competition – Call for Presentations:*

Has your paper just been published? Introduce it to your FSV UK colleagues, join the competition and win the Dean's Price 10.000 CZK.

Who can participate: PhD Students of FSV UK and academic or research employees of FSV UK that have defended their dissertation thesis later than January 1st, 2020.

Which research can be presented: Research that has been published in original articles in English in the year 2021, articles must be in [OBD](#) till January 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Authors with more articles can compete just with one of them.

Application: Please, look [here](#) for more understanding of the competition format. You can apply [here](#) till January 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Necessary condition is that you upload with your application a five minute video that introduces your research (can be recorded very easily e.g. in zoom).

Rules:

Participants present a poster about their research during the poster session. Poster session will be open on February 8th from 15:30 in [Zoom on this link](#). Choice of finalists will be at 17:30 by voting of all PhD students, academic and research employees of FSV UK present in Zoom. Three best presentations will go into the final + the best presentation from participants from the PhD study programmes that are not among the three best presentations.

Finalists present during the final session in random order. Final session will be open on February 9th from 15:30 in [Zoom on this link](#). Each finalist gets 10 minutes for their presentation + 10 more minutes for discussion. Winner will be chosen by voting of a jury and by voting of all PhD students, academic and research employees of FSV UK present in Zoom after the discussion of the last presentation; both votings have the same weight. Jury's members cover all programmes which students participate in the competition.

Price for winner: Dean's price 10.000,-CZK

Condition for realization: At least five applicants from at least 2 PhD study programmes
