


Here's a practical guide on how to use it!






- 1. To have access to the online catalogue, you first have to register with your CAS account $\frac{\text{here}}{\text{Model}} \rightarrow \frac{\text{Description}}{\text{Model}}$
- 2. Sign in the UKAZ page with your CAS login \longrightarrow $\stackrel{\text{\tiny WAZ}}{\longrightarrow}$
- 3. You can look for a topic or a specific book/article







4. Once you looked for the topic, you can check the availability and the resource type


