- M master level.

1. Students can register for courses of max 32 ETCS per semester.



The minimum for bachelor-level students is 20 ECTS The minimum for master-level students is 15 ECTS

- 2. More than 51% of the registered courses MUST be from the hosting faculty.
- 3. Student can visit only 1 sports course and it must be in the Learning Agreement.
