

## Call for nominations (as at: January 2024)

## Exchange scholarship for students from HHU partner universities

Who is eligible?	Students with a non-German university entrance qualification studying at a university outside Germany with which a Cooperation Agreement exists or is to be concluded.
	The partner university may nominate one candidate per selection round.
What is the objective of the scholarship?	To strengthen international partnerships in all faculties through the exchange of students.
Which conditions must be fulfilled?	<ul> <li>The nominees from the partner university have a non-German university entrance qualification.</li> <li>Confirmation of academic supervision from an HHU lecturer is available.</li> </ul>
Scope and duration of funding	Funding of up to €934 per month can be provided for up to 5 months (no extension possible).  Living costs in Düsseldorf amount to around €980 per month.
	Living costs in Dusseidori amount to around e 300 per month.
Who nominates candidates?	The International Office of the respective partner university selects a suitable candidate in line with the scholarship objective and nominates them <b>online</b> :  Nomination form for the winter semester 2024/25
Who <u>cannot</u> be nominated?	Students with a non-German university entrance qualification who receive funding via Erasmus or from a scholarship organisation at the same time.
Deadline for nominations	20 March for the winter semester, 20 October for the summer semester.
Application deadline at the home university	Defined by the home university.
Application documents	<ol> <li>Written confirmation from an HHU lecturer that they are willing to provide the usual level of academic supervision for the student</li> <li>Certificate of enrolment from the partner university</li> <li>Proof of German and/or English language proficiency</li> </ol>
Who makes the selection?	An HHU selection committee.
What are the selection criteria?	<ul> <li>A complete application has been submitted on time.</li> <li>In the event that the number of applications received exceeds the amount of funding available, priority will be given to partner universities which have not received funding in the past or which have not received funding for a longer period.</li> </ul>
