Two strategic priorities:

- ❑ To increase the rate of success of our PhD studies – Academic Year 2020 – 2021**
- ❑ To increase the quality of our PhD programmes**

Another priority has appeared recently on the university level: To increase the graduation rate

Rate of success = number of successful defenses/number of students in the 4th and higher years of study

Graduation rate = number of successful defenses/number of students up to the 5th year of study

- Increase of stipends for best students**
- Support of co-tutelle or joint and double-degree forms of PhD study programmes**

- Master students as research assistants**
- PhD studies as basis for postdoc appointment at research universities**
