The aim of the conference is to exchange experiences and reflections between scientists, researchers and practitioners from different fields of science and social life areas dealing with gender concepts and their influence on the functioning of men and women in society. This will provide an opportunity to learn about the theoretical approaches, concepts and research results on gender issues in order to gain a better understanding and explore the relationship between society and gender. During the two-day conference we plan not only to hold a presentations of the submitted papers, but also a discussion panel allowing us to share our experiences and freely discuss the problems, challenges and research perspectives related to the proposed topic with representatives of various academic centres and organizations.

The conference is dedicated to Professor Ewa Malinowska, who celebrates the 47th anniversary of her scientific and didactic work. Therefore we plan a session devoted to scientific problems which are the subject of the Jubilarian's theoretical and empirical interests. The session will include the



gender approach in social research, the phenomenon of genderisation of social life in patriarchal society, and feminism and women's movement.

Professor Ewa Malinowska is, among others, the author of the book "European Feminism, Parity Democracy and the Polish Women's Movement" (2000). In connection with the 100-year anniversary of Polish women's obtaining electoral rights and the current political and social situation in Poland we would like to return to the motives and engage in a scientific discussion on issues of gender equality and inequality, the significance of feminism as a social movement in the transformations of modern society, the picture of democracy seen from a feminist perspective.

The invitation to the conference is addressed to researchers who represent social sciences and humanities, as well as to all those interested in the indicated issues.

- "Przegląd Socjologii Jakościowej" (Qualitative Sociology Review) (13 points list of scored journals of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education).

The organisers also plan to issue a peer-reviewed scientific monograph.

We will inform you about technical and organizational details of the event in the separate announcement, to be sent after qualifying the speaker for participation in the conference.
