NOMINATION & APPLICATION PROCESS

1 step

Students have to be nominated for the Exchange Program by their home university coordinator, the following documents should be enclosed:

- Application Form
- CV
- Motivation Letter
- Study plan
- Transcript of Records
- Letter of Recommendation
- Copy of the Passport

English Language Requirement - minimum level B2

Students who are not native speakers will be asked to demonstrate their ability to study in English with an official language certificate or one issued by home university.

2 step

The Application must be signed by the student and checked by the HU coordinator*.

The HU coordinator will email the application with all the documents together to the International Office of FSV UK.

3 step

Once the student is accepted, we will inform the HU coordinator and post-acceptance, housing and visa (if needed) document to their address.

Our faculty offers over 200 courses per semester.

Students can also study various languages at the Faculty of Social Sciences UK.

Every course has a unique code e.g. JEB111 where the third letter states the level of the course.

B - bachelor level

M - master level

D - doctoral level

Students of Bachelor level can register for a course of a master level unless it is restricted by the teacher of the course (note in the syllabus).

Students can register for courses in total of appx 30 ETCS per semester.

At least half of the registered courses have to be from the FSV UK.

Students from non-EU and non-EFTA countries will need a student visa. To obtain their visa in a timely manner, we strongly recommend students to submit their applications as early as possible.

Visa process may take up to 3 months.

- Semester-length students should apply for a student visa (long-stay visa for the purpose of study)
- Full year students (2 semesters) should apply for a long-term residence permit.
