NOMINATION PROCESS

Students are nominated for the Exchange Program by their HU coordinator*. Following information (<u>filled in nomination table</u>) is emailed to **studyabroad@fsv.cuni.cz**

- Student's Full Name
- Student's First Name
- Student's Last Name (Family Name)
- Student's Email address.
- Student's Date of Birth (MM/DD/YYYY)
- Student's Study Program
- Student's Study Program Cycle: Bachelor/Master
- Student's Year of Study
- Speacial Needs: Yes/No

Every received nomination is confirmed with the HU coordinator by the coordinator of FSV UK and followed with an email to the prospective exchange student (with the HU coordinator in the copy) with the application instructions.

APPLICATION PROCESS

<u>1 step</u>

Students receive an email with application instructions from the coordinator of FSV UK. They are asked to submit following documents by email:

- Application Form
- CV
- Motivation Letter
- Study plan
- Transcript of Records
- Letter of Recommendation
- Copy of the Passport

<u>English Language Requirement - min level B2</u>

Students who are not native speakers will be asked to demonstrate their ability to study in English with an official language certificate or one issued by home university.

2 step

The Application must be signed by the student and the HU coordinator.

The student or the HU coordinator will email the application with all the documents together to the International Office of FSV UK.

3 step

Once the student is accepted, coordinator of FSV UK will inform the student and send them acceptance and housing documents by email as well as to their address. The documents are shipped by DHL and students are required to cover the shipping costs.*

Our faculty offers over 200 courses per semester.

Students can also study various languages at the Faculty of Social Sciences UK.

Every course has a unique code e.g. JEB111 where the third letter states the level of the course.

B - bachelor level

M - master level

D - doctoral level

Students of Bachelor level can register for a course of a master level unless it is restricted by the teacher of the course (note in the syllabus).

Students can register for courses in total of approx 32 ECTS per semester.

At least 51% of the registered courses have to be from the FSV UK.

Or other, depends on the available capacity.

Students from non-EU and non-EFTA countries will need a student visa. To obtain their visa in a timely manner, we strongly recommend students to submit their applications as early as possible.

Visa process may take up to 3 months.

- Semester-length students should apply for a student visa (long-stay visa for the purpose of study)
- Full year students (2 semesters) should apply for a long-term residence permit.
