








- Documentation of language proficiency (preferably a language certificate)

Required documents:

- Information of study results at the FSV (SIS results with indicated GPA)
- Information on an estimated dates of a short-term mobility, name of a pre-arranged organization and the name, telephone number and email of a contact person
- Approval of a short-stay mobility by the Academic tutor

- finishing the process at European Office CU by signing the Erasmus Financial Agreement









The modules include seminars, debates and workshops with leading academics and practitioners; professional skills training; and substantial teamwork. Over the two years, the Scholars operate in small multidisciplinary groups on a project designed and conducted entirely by them to "make Europe a better place". The final proposals are evaluated by a panel of experts and presented at an international conference.




Sasakawa Young Leaders Fellowship Fund (SYLFF)






