

Are you staying at a **Charles University Dormitory**?





In this case you **don't need to visit the Foreign Police Office** in person. You will be registered by the dormitory office at the moment of your arrival.



Are you staying at a **Charles University Dormitory**?







Then you have to visit the Foreign Police Office in person

- within 30 days after your arrival if you come from a EU/EFTA country
- within 3 days if you come from a third country


YOU WILL NEED:

- Passport/ID
- Registration Card: available at the registration or it can be <u>printed</u> and filled out in advance
- Health insurance valid for the Czech Republic (EHIC or private health insurance)
- House rental (lease) agreement, possibly in Czech language

...and a book/music/something to eat to kill time in case of queues :-)




In case you move during your stay in Prague, you have to register again at the police and report your new address within 30 days.






Here you take your queue number:
