Students'suggestions – (just some examples)

I think students would strongly benefit from being better connected to faculty and other Ph.D. students. This is usually achieved with social events, that is never the case in IES. One more very important topic is preparing Ph.D. students for the job market - this is essential for the Ph.D. student's future and many faculties put immense effort and hours into preparing their Ph.D. students for it; however, nothing of this sort is done at IES. And, scholarship is not even close to being enough - it is true that starting from the second year, grants add up and one reaches minimum salary, but it is not guaranteed, and the first year is very tough for those that don't have family funds to support them. Working a job and doing high-quality research on a Ph.D. program is impossible, so students are facing a tough reality.

I need more engagement with fellows through (creative) academic activities which is supported by student hub (co-working space) and sophisticated library collection.

More administrative support is needed by the university. There is literally no space available for PhD students to work in the department. More engrossing PhD-related activities should be introduced, the overall Ph.D. study process is not dynamic at all it feels so lonely and depressing.

I think enabling people to submit a dissertation consisting of published journal articles rather than forcing them to write hundred-odd pages long thesis-style 'books' would make PhD programmes much more efficient and make our PhD porgrammes more competitive.

Students'suggestions – (just some examples)

I think the program is not sustainable as it currently is - the general duties should either be limited or there should be higher scholarship but to complete about 11 courses, teaching and assisting at the faculty, 3 conferences, 3 publications, in my case even 4 since i m not the only one author within 2 of them, and to write phd disseration - these all within 4 years while the basic scholarship is 10 500 CZK is a kind of like being said to get from Prague to Brno within 30 min, either, the requirement must be limited or the study period prolonged or higher scholarship in order to cover 50% life expenses (it is meant as a reference to general situation, I, personally, have got some grants which allowed me to dont give up
