







Some courses have lectures and practicals. If so, you must enroll in both.






To see the list of enrolled courses, go to Enrolled.

What to do when the course is full?

- O Do not panic!
- Enroll into the waiting list.
- Email the professor.
 - If the **professor confirms** your spot **by email**, forward the professor's email to us and **we can add you** to the course.
- Make a plan B course selection search for more courses



- Erasmus+ students must take at least 51 % of their courses (or earn the same number
 - of credits) at the Faculty where they were nominated to.

- Erasmus+ ICM students should take at least 51 % of their courses (or earn the same
 - number of credits) at the institute where they were nominated to.

Your study plan has to reflect all the changes. Your <u>IO coordinator</u> will sign it
only after the add and drop period is finished. But first have it approved by your home
university.

- Do not panic if your dream course is full.
