The international project - "The Art of Peace" is a two-stages project that follows the logical frame - starting with giving tools for working on personal development, aiming at improving peace building attitudes and skills through the self-development process.

The project contains 2 stages of the Training Courses, with different focuses.

STAGE 1

23-30 October 2018 in Georgia


The first stage of the project will be held in Bakuriani, Georgia, focusing on personal development. Personal development is a lifelong process. It's a way for people to assess their skills and qualities, consider their aims in life and set goals in order to realize and maximize their potential. Early life development and early formative experiences within the family, at school, etc. can help to shape us as adults, personal development should not stop later in life. This project is designed to help youth workers to think about their personal development and ways in which they can work towards goals and their full potential.

STAGE 2

31 March - 7thApril 2019 in Czech Republic

2nd Training Course will be held in Škrdlovice, Czech Republic, focusing on coaching. Details about it will be sent later. This 2 level project helps to identify the skills needed to set life goals which can raise the confidence of young participants, enhance their employability prospects, how they relate with themselves & others and will lead to a more fulfilling, higher quality life. Plan to make relevant, positive and effective life choices and decisions for their future to enable personal empowerment.

AIMS & OBJECTIVES



Main aims & objectives of the project:

- To stimulate the self-development process of the participants;
- To increase employability and participation of youth workers, develop their professional skills and increase their efficiency;
- To give the tools of coaching and supporting the youngsters in own communities:
- To get intercultural experience by meeting with the representatives of different countries, cultures, backgrounds, religions, practice tolerance and break stereotypes & prejudices;
- To build partnership and future cooperation on the basis of this project and improve the quality of local and international youth work.




METHODOLOGY

The team of trainers has a huge background in this field and has been implementing many projects for youth workers around the world.

The methodology is based on learning by doing, which refers to the process of making meanings from direct experience. The method has been implemented by the concepts of learning by thinking and learning by loving. Learning by thinking denotes the action of reflecting on the process going on, in order to get knowledge from it. Finally, learning by loving expresses the importance given to motivation and passion that enrich the learning experience.

The methodology is based on the concepts of developing and challenging individuals and groups through a creative stimulation that connects objective contents with personal experience and internalization. The exercises (called 'processes') may involve talking, while in another participants will be listening or visualizing certain thoughts. Exercises will be provided in combination with music, dance or play. There are both indoor and outdoor processes.

Cultural presentation:

During the TC will be organized cultural evenings where all the countries will present their culture (dances, songs, and typical food).

ACCOMODATION

Accommodation will be provided Bakuriani, Georgia.

Participants will be allocated in three-bedded and four-bedded rooms.

Every bedroom will have a bathroom.

Rooms will be divided according to the same gender, but different nationalities.

3 meals per day will be provided in the hotel.

The accommodation for you is booked and paid 1st. stage - from 23rd October till the morning of 30th of October (the last financed night it's on 29st of October).

If you want to arrive a day earlier or/and stay a night longer, it is possible (you have only two extra days to stay out of the project).

This extra nights are on your expenses.

Wireless internet connection is available in the hotel

Participants have 2 extra days to stay out of project dates.
