ONLINE COURSE REGISTRATION at FSV UK General Information



 All courses at FSV UK will be offered online.

This form of study is guaranteed for the winter semester only.

 Students in Prague are strongly encouraged to take classes in hybrid form





Scenario 1: I decided to study online from my home country the whole winter semester.

Student has a visa issue, or cannot arrive because of the pandemic situation.

The student should register for:

- 1) courses offered online only
- 2) hybrid courses, but needs to contact relevant professor(s) about his/her study remotely.

Scenario 2: I cannot arrive at the beginning of the semester because of the visa delay, but I would like to come later.

The student should take hybrid courses, but needs to contact relevant professor(s) about his/her study remotely. When the student arrives, he/she should start courses on site.

Scenario 3: I will arrive on site and start classes on September 29.

The student should take hybrid courses and start courses on site.

When a student studying on site does not feel well, he/she will stay at home and will contact the relevant professor(s) about the study online.

 All study obligations must be deliverable in their full value without the need for physical presence.


Online courses



Credits

- We recommend exchange/visiting students **minimum of 20 ECTS for bachelor** level students, **minimum of 15 ECTS for master** level students.
- Nevertheless, remember you always have to fulfill criteria given by your home university.

CU Faculties

- Erasmus and other programs' students should take at least 51 % of their courses (or earn the same number of credits) at our faculty (FSV UK). The remaining courses can be chosen from other faculties of the university.
- Erasmus+ ICM students should take at least 51 % of their courses (or earn the same number of credits) at the institute where they were nominated to.



ONLINE COURSE REGISTRATION

Consists of two online steps:

- 1) Enrolment into CAS (Central Authentication Service)
- 2) Course Registration in SIS (Student Information System)





Enrolment into CAS (Central Authentication Service)

- Every student should have received login name and password by email in a last few days.
- Please, change your password within 5 days
- Without this login, you will NOT be able to register for courses
- Login into <u>CAS</u>

PLEASE REMEMBER!


- The sooner you enroll, the better.

CZECH LANGUAGE COURSES

Czech as a Foreign Language



Czech language courses are especially designed for students from degree programmes and Erasmus students (including students from other university faculties). They are taught from the beginner level and students can enroll in each course both in the winter and summer semester.

Tuition fees:

Degree programme students do not pay an extra fee. This will be settled with the institute they study at. Erasmus and PhD. students pay **4,800,-** CZK per semester in the Hollar building at the cash office.
