September, 2024. However, if you decide to arrive early, please remember this is your personal decision, and that the extra days are not part of your studies.

Late Arrivals

If you are going to arrive late, <u>kindly inform us in</u> <u>advance</u>, and we will arrange a meeting at our office to dispatch all the administrative issues regarding your arrival.

If you are planning to <u>move into the dorm later</u>, it is important that you <u>inform the Housing Office</u> in advance. Otherwise, you will not be accommodated and your reservation will not be held.

VISA

Students from non-EU and non-EFTA countries will need a student visa. To obtain their visa in a timely manner, we strongly recommend students to submit their applications as early as possible.

Visa process may take up to 3 months.

- Semester-length students should apply for a student visa (long-stay visa for the purpose of study)
- Full year students (2 semesters) should apply for a long-term residence permit.

In the search engine students are required to choose the <u>Faculty of Social Sciences</u>,

Semester: Winter/Summer/Both

Students can also study various languages at the Faculty of Social Sciences UK.

Every course has a unique code e.g. JEB111 where the third letter states the level of the course.

B - bachelor level

M - master level

D - doctoral level

Students of Bachelor level can register for a course of a master level unless it is restricted by the teacher of the course (note in the syllabus).

Our faculty offers 200 courses per semester.

COURSE RULES

Students can register for courses in total of approx 32 ECTS per semester.

At least 51% of the registered courses has to be from the FSV UK.

Students can register for sport courses offered by Faculty of Arts.

Maximum 1 sports course per student.

CZECH LANGUAGE CLASSES

FSV UK offers a number of Czech language classes at various levels, from Beginners to Intermediate.

Duration: 12 weeks of classes with 6 teaching hours of instruction per week

ECTS: 6

Registration for the classes in SIS, course code: JLB100 - JLB103

Fee: 4,800CZK per semester of 2024/2025
