Dear Students,

This is preliminary information about the "FSV UK Welcome Week for PhD Students" that we will have from September 21st to September 24th 2020.

On Monday September 21st at 2:00 p.m., General Assembly of PhD Students will be at Opletalova 26, room 109. You will get more detail about the program during the first half of September.

From Tuesday September 22nd to Thursday September 24th, there are pedagogical and publishing skills seminars prepared for you, please look at the table below. Seminar "How to get published" on September 23rd at 4:10 p.m. is open for all institutes PhD students and it is not necessary to register in advance - just come. This seminar will be held by Prof. Evžen Kočenda, who is one of the most published and of the most cited social scientists in this country.

Following information about the "Pedagogical Skills Seminars" differs for PhD students from the Institute of Economic Studies - where these seminars are obligatory for some students and registering is organized by the Centre of Doctoral Studies of the IES, and for all other PhD students from our Faculty.

So, for all other students of our faculty: There are four seminars on **Wednesday September 23rd** running from 9:30 to 4:00 p.m. If you are interested, please feel free to register <u>here</u> until September 8th. All four seminars are linked together, so you are expected to be in all four - if you register. There are 25 open spaces and you will be served according to the FIFO (first in first out) rule. These seminars are organized by the Language Centre of our faculty and registered students will be contacted by the Language Centre after September 8th and assigned to the Microteaching slots that will be on September 24th. There will be just 6-7 students in the Microteaching slots and you will have the possibility to practice there what you have learned on the day before - so you will visit just one of these slots.
