General Information

Master in Area Studies (MAS) is an interdisciplinary two-year master's program that focuses on either Europe, Eurasia or North America's modern history and current developments. The program provides a detailed and systematic understanding of the area's current challenges. The main aim of MAS is to educate area studies specialists to be able to adapt easily to a multicultural and multidisciplinary environment. Students have the opportunity to compile their own curriculum to reflect their personal interests, or they may choose from two suggested study tracks:

The US and Global Affairs track introduces students to skills essential for the analysis of US foreign policy, its structural underpinnings and their impact across the globe and in various policy fields.

Transition and Integration in Europe track focuses on the study of the latest development of the post-communist European countries with respect to the transition from the communist society and integration into the Euro-Atlantic structures.
