She started her professional career in 2003 and till 2012 worked on the different positions in various departments of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Georgia. She also served as a deputy head of mission at the Embassy of Georgia in Estonia. In addition, in 2013-2017 years, she held the position of Deputy State Minister of Georgia on European and Euro-Atlantic Integration. The office of the state minister was a government agency within the cabinet of Ministers of Georgia in charge of coordinating Georgia's key foreign policy Priority-European and Euro Atlantic Integration. She has an academic degree of bachelor with a focus on Architecture and an academic master degree with a focus on International Relations and European Law.
