- PhD students who have teaching experience or would be interested in obtaining it in the future
- All those who are interested in innovations in higher education teaching and internationalization of the curriculum and are open to sharing

Format of meetings:

- The first meeting will take place in the Jinonice building on December 12 from 9:30 to 11:00
- Following meetings 3x 90 min during the academic year (aprox. 1 / month outside of the exam period)

Furthermore we invite you to:

- Informal coffees with the project team which is at your disposal
- Personal consultations with external expert who can advise you with a new syllabus or give you feedback on one of for sessions in your course
